English Calligraphy Competition

1. Competition Format

Participants are required to handwrite the following poem using a ball pen or pencil.

There are two categories: Junior Group (P1 - P3) and Senior Group (P4 - P6).

3. Format Requirements

- (a) Use the official writing paper template provided above.
- (b) The length of the poem is fixed; participants must write the entire poem mentioned below.
- (c) File Format: PDF file (A4 size).
- (d) File Naming Convention:
- i) Group submission with multiple entries in one PDF: English Calligraphy Competition_School Name_Category_Number of Entries (Example: English Calligraphy Competition_Kwai Chung Primary School_Senior Group_35 entries)
- ii) Individual participant submitting one entry: English Calligraphy Competition_School Name_Category_Participant's Name (Example: English Calligraphy Competition_Kwai Chung Primary School_Senior Group_Chan Tai Man)

4. Judging Criteria

- Writing Technique (60%): Neat and tidy handwriting, fluid strokes.
- Overall Aesthetics (40%): The overall layout and artistic sense of the work.

All submissions must be the participant's own handwritten work.
